

Eligibility Requirements

How WE PLAY IT SAFE with FPD Programs

In order to keep everyone safe we ask that program participants be able to follow these guidelines in addition to Freeport Park District's behavior guidelines to be eligible for programs during this time.

FREEPORT PARK DISTRICT PROGRAM PARTICIPANT ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Participation is not allowed if you are experiencing COVID related symptoms, including but not limited to, fever in the past 72 hours
- Participation is not allowed if you had close contact with someone diagnosed with COVID-19 in the last 14 days
- Participants must be able to independently provide personal self-care
- Participants must be able to independently put on and wear a mask when physical distancing is not possible
- Participants must be able to practice physical distancing with verbal and visual reminders
- Participants will need to be able to refrain from outburst and physically aggressive behaviors such as biting, spitting, scratching, hitting, kicking etc...
- Participants must be able to stay near the group and not run or wander away
- Participants must be able to comply with verbal and visual instructions
- Participants must be able to be responsible for personal items with verbal/visual prompts and reminders
- Participation is not allowed if you are experiencing COVID related symptoms
- Program may be canceled if exposure to COVID occurs
- Guidelines for individual programs may have further requirements

Failure to follow these requirements may result in removal from the program due to the current mandates, CDC guidelines and local health department guidance.
